Eagle Cap Youth Musicals (ECYM) is a program of the Wallowa Valley Music Alliance (WVMA) and is a youth-serving organization dedicated to providing music and theatre learning and performance opportunities for the youth of Wallowa County.

By participating in our programs, you agree to follow these rules.

We expect you to:

- Treat everyone – staff, volunteers, and other participants – with kindness, respect, and fairness.
