Eagle Cap Youth Musicals (ECYM) is a program of the Wallowa Valley Music Alliance (WVMA) and is a youth-serving organization dedicated to providing music and theatre learning and performance opportunities for the youth of Wallowa County.

By participating in our programs, you agree to follow these rules.

- Possession or use of alcohol, drugs, or dangerous items on program property.
- Breaking rules or ignoring safety procedures.
- Taking unfair advantage of others.

If you break this code, you may be asked to leave the program.
